Synthetic Division

*can only be used if the divisor is linear with LC = 1
example- $x+4$ or $x-5$

Divide $5x^3 + 6x + 8$ by $x + 2$

≡

$$\begin{array}{r|rrrr} -2 & 5 & 0 & 6 & 8 \\ & & -10 & 20 & -52 \\ \hline & 5 & -10 & 26 & -44 \end{array}$$

$$5x^2 - 10x + 26 - \frac{44}{x+2}$$

...

Divide $x^3 - 7x - 6$ by $x+2$

$$\begin{array}{r|rrrr} -2 & 1 & 0 & -7 & -6 \\ & & -2 & 4 & 6 \\ \hline & 1 & -2 & -3 & 0 \end{array}$$

$$= x^2 - 2x - 3$$
